- 3) Abu Hurayrah (may Allaah be pleased with him) said: "I heard the Prophet PBUH say, "None of you should fast on a Friday unless he fasts the day before or the day after." [al-Bukhaari & Muslim]
- 4) Reward for fasting six days in Shawwal, The Prophet PBUH explained this when he said: "Whoever fasts for six days after (Eid) al-Fitr has completed the year." [Muslim, Abu-Dawood, al-Tirmidhi, al-Nisaa'l and Ibn Maajah]
